If you don't receive the link and do not have outstanding 2024/2025 balances, please contact the office to receive the link.

Member Rate Eligibility: To receive 2026 member rates, all 2024/2025 balances must be paid in full, or a payment plan is established. If one is *unwilling* to pay in full or set up an affordable payment plan, seats will be available at the non-member rate.

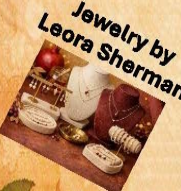

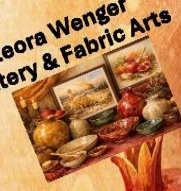
